Staff presented the concept and plan of creating a Food Truck program to be held Central Park during the summer months and the 6 Stones Community Garden during the fall. The Parks and Recreation Advisory Board agreed that this program would be a great addition to the parks system.

- **Brook Hollow Park:** Tree limb down along the creek. Pavilion needs to be taken down. Signs need to be implemented letting visitors know about leash rules in the park. Section of fence is missing.
- Carousel Park: Testing on going on pressure plane.
- Central Park: Central Park looks good.
- Harris Ryals Park: Harris Ryals Park looks good.
- **Meadowpark/Bark Park:** Great improvements in the park. The water is back on. There is standing water outside of Bark Park.
- Monterrey Park: The red tips are gone.
- Stormie Jones Park: The fields are looking good.

7. Staff updates on recreation on:

Summer pool staff is being hired. The pool is being filled and the parks staff have been making repairs to the facility.
