

ORDINANCE NO. 10-2975

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SCHEDULE OF WATER RATES BY AMENDMENT OF SECTION 1. ORDINANCE NO. 09-2941; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEDFORD, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 09-2941, Section 1, SCHEDULE OF WATER RATES is hereby amended to read as follows:

"WATER RATES"

A schedule of monthly rates and charges for water service furnished by the City's Waterworks shall be and is hereby adopted and established as follows:

(a) With the exception of multi-family dwellings the minimum charge for various size meters per month shall be:

(1) 5/8 or 3/4" meter	\$18.37	\$ 15.97
(2) 5/8 or 3/4" meter (over 65)	\$16.70	\$ 14.52
(3) 1" meter	\$36.73	\$31.94
(4) 1" meter (over 65)	\$33.40	\$29.04
(5) 1 1/2" meter	\$73.47	\$63.89
(6) 2" meter	\$117.59	\$102.25
(7) 3" meter	\$220.49	\$191.73
(8) 4" meter	\$352.82	\$306.80
(9) 6" meter	\$1,323.04	\$1,150.47
(10) 6" Fire Hydrant meter	\$194.60	\$169.22

(b) INSIDE CITY LIMITS:

- (1) Minimum charge per month in (a) above.**
- (2) All water used per month: \$2.89 /1,000 gallons**

(c) OUTSIDE CITY LIMITS - SINGLE-FAMILY AND COMMERCIAL, DUPLEX, AND MULTI-FAMILY RATES

- (1) Charges shall be twice the amount as charged to a like resident of the City.**

SECTION 2. REPEALING CLAUSE

This ordinance shall be and is hereby declared to be cumulative of all other ordinances of the City of Bedford, and shall not operate to repeal or affect any of such other ordinances except insofar as the provisions thereof might be inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, in which event such conflicting provisions, if any, in such other ordinance or ordinances are hereby repealed

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE

If any provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder of such ordinance shall not be deemed to affect the validity of any other section or provisions of said ordinance.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall become effective with all water billed on or after October 1, 2010.
