



**City of Bedford

Liquid Waste Transporter
Permitting Information**

In order to be permitted:

1. Call for an appointment to have your truck(s) inspected if you do not already have proof of current inspection from Dallas, Fort Worth, Arlington, and Haltom City: **(817) 952-2224**.

2. The location for inspection and registration is: **Bedford Public Works Service Center
1813 Reliance Pkwy
Bedford, Texas 76021.**

3. Bring the following information to the registration location:

- Application for Waste Transportation Permit
 - Complete by typing or legible printing
- Driver's License photocopies for the OWNER, MANAGER, AND DRIVERS
- Proof of Insurance
- Proof of Inspection (or proof of inspection from Dallas, Fort Worth, Arlington, Haltom City)
- Registration with TCEQ
- Annual Permit Fee
 - **\$240 for the first truck, \$130 for each additional (trip tickets included)**

4. Trucks must be re-permitted annually.

The expiration date for all permits is December 31 of the current year.

REQUIREMENTS OF PERMITTED WASTE HAULERS

1. Mark each registered vehicle
 - a. The decal shall be placed on each side of each vehicle
2. Don't mix incompatible wastes
3. Satisfy the full pump out requirement for grease traps
4. Store wastes properly
5. Dispose of wastes legally
6. Transfer wastes properly
7. Watch for leaks
8. Clean up and report spills
9. Keep your registration information up to date
 - a. Notify the City of Bedford in writing of changes to your operation or registration print out such as:
 - i. Changing the business name, physical address, mailing address, or telephone number
 - ii. Adding or replacing motor vehicles
10. Renew your registration annually
 - a. Every year your registration will expire on December 31. To renew your registration, you must complete the same form you used for your original application and submit it to us by November 1 of that year. Submit all the required information with the necessary documentation and payment to:
 - i. City of Bedford Attn: Permitting, 1813 Reliance Parkway, Bedford, TX 76021
 - ii. Make copies for your records.
11. Cancel your registration when you stop hauling
