JOB SUMMARY: Under direct supervision, responsible for front line fire, EMS, rescue, hazardous materials and support operations demonstrating knowledge of departmental policies, procedures, and EMS protocols. Will maintain emergency vehicles and facilities. May provide related training to the public as needed. This position is essential to emergency operations and therefore in the event of an emergency, all employees are required, and therefore must have the ability to respond to emergency situations off-duty.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- High School Diploma or GED.
- Texas Commission on Fire Protection Basic Firefighter certificate required.
- Texas Department of State Health Services Paramedic certificate required.
- Must have or be able to obtain a Class B CDL or CDL Exempt Texas Driver's License.
- Must be able to pass physical ability test.
