<b>JOB SUMMARY:</b>	Performs activities to install, maintain, repair, service, and relocate wastewater facilities. Operates and services equipment such as jetter trucks, backhoes, front end loaders, skid steers and other equipment used in repair and maintenance of water and wastewater facilities. Locates, inspects, excavates, cleans, repairs or replaces, and back fills sewer mains and lines.

### **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

- High School Diploma or GED and 3 months related experience and/or training OR equivalent combination of education and experience.
- A valid Texas Driver's License.
- Must be able to perform manual labor in adverse weather conditions.
- Must be able to lift and/or move up to 100 pounds.
- **Preferred:** Texas Class A Commercial Driver's License with tanker endorsement.
- *Must obtain a valid Texas Class B Commercial Driver's License with tanker endorsement within 6 months of employment.*
- *Must obtain a TCEQ Class I Wastewater Collection License, a TCEQ Class D Water License, and a Work Zone Traffic Control Certification within 1 year of employment.*
