JOB SUMMARY: Performs activities to install, maintain, repair, service, and relocate wastewater facilities. Installs sewer taps and repairs damaged manhole rings and covers. Operate equipment such as Vector trucks, Harben, FMC, and other equipment used to repair sewers. Locates, inspects, excavates, cleans, repairs, and/or replaces sewer mains and lines.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- High School Diploma or GED and 3 months related experience and/or training OR equivalent combination of education and experience.
- A valid Texas Driver's License.
- Must be able to perform manual labor in adverse weather conditions.
- Must be able to lift and/or move up to 100 pounds.
- **Preferred:** Texas Class A Commercial Driver's License with tanker endorsement .
- *Must obtain a valid Texas Class B Commercial Driver's License with tanker endorsement within 6 months of employment.*
- *Must obtain a TCEQ Class I Wastewater Collection License within 6 months of employment.*
- *Must obtain a Work Zone Traffic Control Certification within 1 year of employment.*
